2nd Edition

24–25 October 2026 – Florinas Golf

REGULATIONS

Article 1 – Rules and Conditions of Competition

The competition shall be played in accordance with:

- the applicable R&A Rules of Golf;
- the rules of the IPPA – International Pitch & Putt Association;
- the rules of the Italian Pitch & Putt Federation;
- the Specific Conditions of Competition issued for the event;
- the Additional Conditions and Local Rules issued by the Competition Committee.

For all matters not expressly covered by these Regulations, the rules referred to above shall apply, supplemented by the Local Rules of Florinas Golf.

The maximum number of clubs permitted is three: one putter and two irons of the player's choice.

The competition shall be played using a Simplified Medal Stroke Play format: if the ball has not been holed after five strokes, the player must pick it up and record a score of six for the hole.

For breaches carrying the general penalty, one penalty stroke shall apply, except where the rules provide otherwise.

Article 2 – Format of Play

The Sardinia International Pitch & Putt – 2nd Edition shall be played over a total of 54 holes in an individual Simplified Medal Stroke Play format.

The competition schedule is as follows:

Saturday, 24 October 2026

- Round 1 – 18 holes;
- Round 2 – 18 holes.

Sunday, 25 October 2026

- Final Round 3 – 18 holes.

The final standings shall be determined by the total number of strokes recorded over the three rounds.

Article 3 – Eligibility

The competition is open to Italian and international players who comply with the regulations of their respective federation and with all applicable sporting provisions.

The maximum field is 72 players, with at least 36 places reserved for international players.

Italian players shall gain admission through the 2026 qualifying competition circuit organised by Florinas Golf.

At the conclusion of the qualifying competitions, the qualified players shall be identified and shall acquire the right to participate in the event.

The remaining players shall be placed on a waiting list according to their ranking in the qualifying competitions. Places shall be allocated from this list until all available places have been filled.

Thereafter, recourse shall be made to the waiting list comprising players who submitted an entry application, in order of receipt.

Article 4 – Entries

Entries must be submitted in accordance with the procedures specified by Florinas Golf.

An entry shall be considered final only after confirmation by the organisers and payment of the relevant fee.

The entry fee is €70.00 and includes:

- entry to the competition;
- practice round;
- participation in the 54-hole competition;
- final prize-giving ceremony and closing buffet.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to close entries early once the maximum number of participants has been reached.

Article 5 – Order of Play and Starting Times

The order of play for the first and second rounds shall be determined by the Competition Committee.

The starting order for the third round, scheduled for Sunday, 25 October, shall be based on the overall standings after the first 36 holes.

The Competition Committee shall determine and communicate the starting times and procedures.

Article 6 – Standings

The Overall Gross Standings shall be determined by the aggregate gross score over 54 holes.

The winner of the Sardinia International Pitch & Putt – 2nd Edition shall be the player who completes the three rounds in the lowest total number of strokes.

Separate standings shall also be drawn up for the special categories provided for in these Regulations.

Article 7 – Prizes

The total prize fund is €2,000.

Prizes shall be awarded to the top five players in the Overall Gross Standings.

Special prizes shall also be awarded to players finishing from 6th to 10th place in the Overall Gross Standings.

The following category prizes shall also be awarded:

- 1st Lady;
- 1st Junior;
- 1st Senior;

- 1st Master.

Prizes may not be combined.

If the expected number of entries is not reached, the prizes shall be reduced proportionally.

Article 8 – Ties and Play-offs

In the event of a tie for first place overall, an immediate hole-by-hole play-off (sudden death) shall be played on the holes designated by the Competition Committee.

If the play-off cannot be held or completed, the Competition Committee shall determine an alternative method for deciding the winner.

For all other positions in the standings, ties shall be decided by considering, in the following order:

- 1 the best score in the third round;
- 2 the best score over the last 9 holes;
- 3 the best score over the last 6 holes;
- 4 the best score over the last 3 holes;
- 5 the score on the final hole.

If the tie remains, it shall be resolved as determined by the Competition Committee.

Article 9 – Competition Committee

The Competition Committee shall be appointed by Florinas Golf and shall have full responsibility for the technical and sporting management of the competition.

The Committee shall be responsible for interpreting these Regulations, applying the Local Rules, managing starting arrangements, handling any claims, and dealing with all matters not expressly regulated.

Decisions taken by the Competition Committee within the scope of its authority shall be final.

Article 10 – Suspension, Reduction or Cancellation of the Competition

In the event of adverse weather conditions, an unplayable course, safety requirements or other exceptional circumstances, the Competition Committee may suspend, postpone, shorten or amend the competition schedule.

If it is not possible to complete the scheduled 54 holes, the Competition Committee shall determine the validity of the competition and the related standings on the basis of the rounds duly completed by all players concerned.

Article 11 – Acceptance of the Regulations

By entering the Sardinia International Pitch & Putt – 2nd Edition, each participant declares that they are familiar with and fully accept these Regulations, the Local Rules and the instructions issued by the Competition Committee.
